Detailed Itinerary

Day 1: Wed, Oct 3- Depart Boston

Private bus transportation will take the group to Logan for your overnight flight to Dublin. Dinner is served. **(D)**

Day 2: Wed, Oct 4- Dublin - Arrival

Upon arrival at Dublin Airport, you will be met and transferred to your hotel. Remaining of the day is free at leisure to explore this beautiful city on your own. This evening, enjoy dinner and entertainment at The Merry Ploughboy Pub. The show is a highly entertaining performance of live traditional Irish music, song and Irish dancing. Overnight in Dublin. (D)

Day 3: Thu, Oct 5 - Dublin Fair City

Today enjoy a Panoramic Tour of Dublin City. Visit St. Patrick's Cathedral, which was built in honor of Ireland's patron saint. Then visit Guinness Storehouse Brewery, Europe's largest stout producing brewery and home to the Guinness Storehouse. Dinner under own arrangements. Overnight in Dublin. (B)

Day 4: Fri, Oct 6 - Dublin - Waterford

After breakfast, depart Dublin for Waterford. On arrival in Waterford, enjoy a Walking Tour of the oldest city in Ireland. Then enjoy a factory tour at Waterford Crystal for an up close insight into the centuries-old tradition of Waterford Crystal making. In the evening, enjoy a nice dinner (2 courses incl. tea/coffee) and overnight at your hotel in Waterford. (B,D)

Day 5: Sat, Oct 7 - Waterford - Blarney Castle - Killarney

Depart for County Kerry with an en-route visit to Blarney Castle. An ancient stronghold of the McCarthy's, Lords of Muskerry, famous for its Blarney stone - The Stone of Eloquence, which is traditionally believed, to have the power to bestow the gift of eloquence on all those who kiss it. Spend some time at leisure for personal shopping at Blarney Woolen Mills. Then continue to Killarney and on arrival, visit Muckross House and Gardens, which is a magnificent Victorian mansion built in 1843 and is one of Ireland's leading stately homes. *Due to the huge popularity of this attraction this visit is subject to availability. Savor a delicious dinner tonight (2 courses incl. tea/coffee) and overnight at your hotel in Killarney. (B,D)

Day 6: Sun, Oct 8 - Ring of Kerry

Today enjoy touring the Ring of Kerry, Ireland's most famous and panoramic route. Continue through the mountains to Molls Gap and Ladies View with superb views of the famous Lakes of Killarney. Then enjoy a jaunting car ride in Killarney National Park to admire its stunning scenery. Overnight at your hotel in Killarney. (B)

Day 7: Mon, Oct 9- Killarney - Limerick

Depart County Kerry and journey to Limerick. Visit Molanna Dairy Farm which is a working dairy farm of spring calving Friesian cows and family pets such as ponies and a donkey. Continue to Limerick and enjoy a short panoramic tour of it and visit King John's Castle, situated on 'King's Island' in the heart of medieval Limerick City. Overnight at your hotel in Limerick. (B)

Day 8: Tues, Oct 10 - Limerick - Cliffs of Moher-Galway

Today visit the Cliffs of Moher, situated on the Atlantic Ocean and bordering the Burren region. Standing 702 feet above the ground at their highest point and 5 miles long, the Cliffs boast one of the most amazing views in Ireland. Then travel through the Burren Region, containing dozens of megalithic tombs and Celtic crosses. Return to Limerick and enjoy a savory dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight at your hotel in Limerick. (B,D)

Day 9: Wed, Oct 11 - Limerick - Tullamore - County Meath

Depart Limerick for County Meath. En-route visit the Tullamore Dew Heritage Center. Situated right in the heart of Ireland, there is an special experience that has been waiting for you since 1829. The newly renovated home of Tullamore D.E.W. Irish Whiskey allows you to immerse yourself in the history and magic that lies inside the walls of this 19th century bonded warehouse, where its whiskey making tradition began. Enjoy a guided tour which blends audiovisual and traditional storytelling and then raise a glass of complimentary Tullamore D.E.W. Irish Whiskey. Remainder of the day and evening at leisure. In the evening, enjoy a farewell dinner (2 courses incl. tea/coffee) and overnight at your hotel in County Cavan. **(B,D)**

Day 10: Thu, Oct 12 - Dublin - Return

After breakfast, you will be transferred to Dublin Airport to board your flight back home. **(B)**
